

# REPORT SNIFFING IN CENTRAL AUSTRALIA

IT IS **MANDATORY** TO REPORT PEOPLE WHO ARE SNIFFING IF THEY ARE UNDER 18  
S15 and 24 – Care and Protection of Children Act NT

## IF YOU THINK ANYONE IS SNIFFING

### You must report to

#### CLINIC

A health check is important

#### NTG DEPT. TERRITORY FAMILIES, CENTRAL INTAKE

You don't need proof of harm or abuse to report your concerns - you just need a reasonable belief that a child has been harmed or is likely to be harmed.

**Call 1800 700 250**

#### POLICE

This does not get the person in trouble with the law.

Police can take the substance and move the person to a safe place.
