




Talking Story

Do you think she did the right thing?

Did Emma remember to log-out?

If her sister Lucy wasn't around, who else might Emma be able to talk to about it?

What are the other things Emma can do, when she sees messages, comments or photos online that she doesn't like?

Emma knows Shelly and Martina, but do you think it is possible that people Emma doesn't know might be contacting her online?

If Emma swore back at Nampitjimpa online, what might happen?

What did Lucy do when her sister Emma told her what had happened?

Do you think what Lucy did was a hard thing to do? Why/Why not?

What did you like about the way Lucy spoke with Nampitjimpa?

If Lucy and Emma got angry with Nampitjimpa, how might the movie have ended?

If Nampitjimpa and Emma had a fight, who else do you think might get involved?
